Uniform

- Plain grey school trousers, shorts, skirt
- White shirt with a school tie
- Black suitable school shoes
- Purple school sweatshirt or cardigan
- Plain grey/black socks or tights
- In summer, children may wear full purple gingham dress or grey shorts

PE Kit (Worn on Active Days – 2 days per week)

- Plain black shorts, jogging bottoms or leggings **without any logos**
- Purple round neck t- shirt with school badge
- Black school pumps or trainers can be worn for PE 'Active Days'
- Pair of short white socks
- School sweatshirt/cardigan or school purple fleece

Parents must write a note in their child's planner if they are unable to wear the correct uniform for any reason. Hair that is long enough to be tied back must be tied back with a plain black or purple hair band. Dyed, shaved and or patterned haircuts are not suitable for school.

Jewellery should not be worn to school. However children may wear one simple pair of silver or gold studs or a single stud. Children may wear a simple wrist watch.

ALL uniform MUST be clearly labelled with your child's name.
