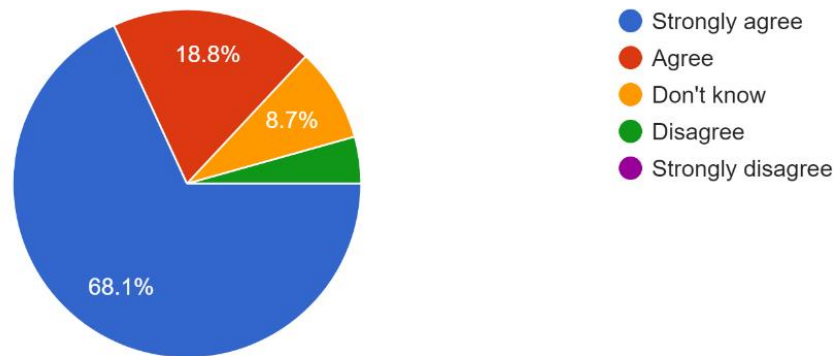

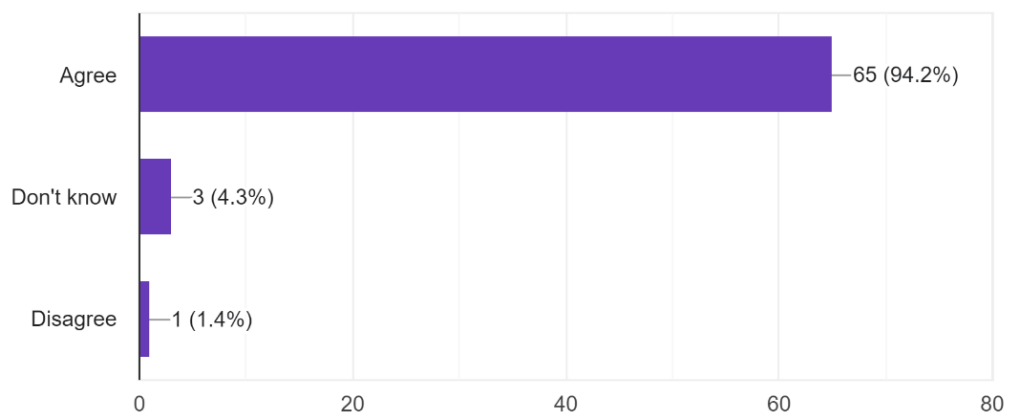


My child is happy at St. Alban's

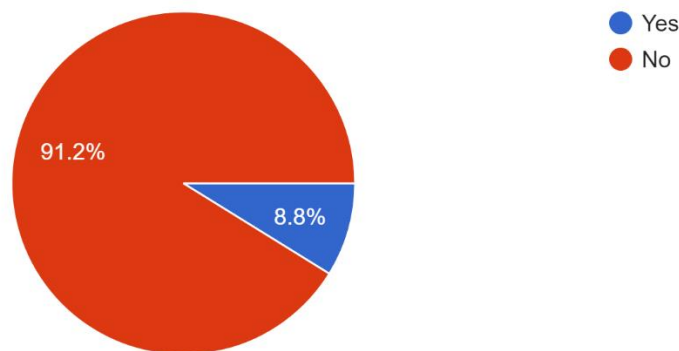

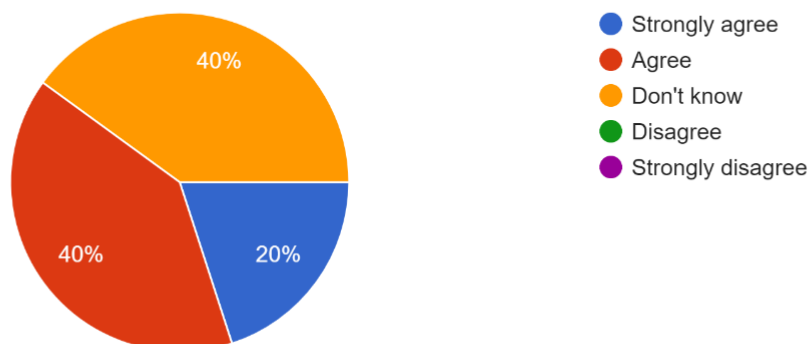
Does your child have SEND?

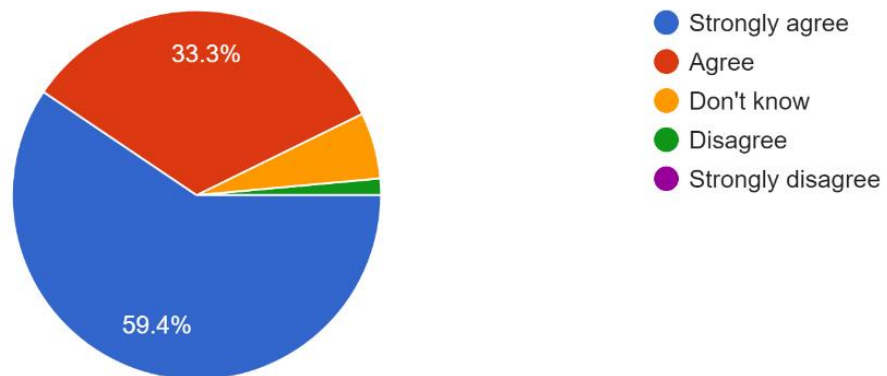

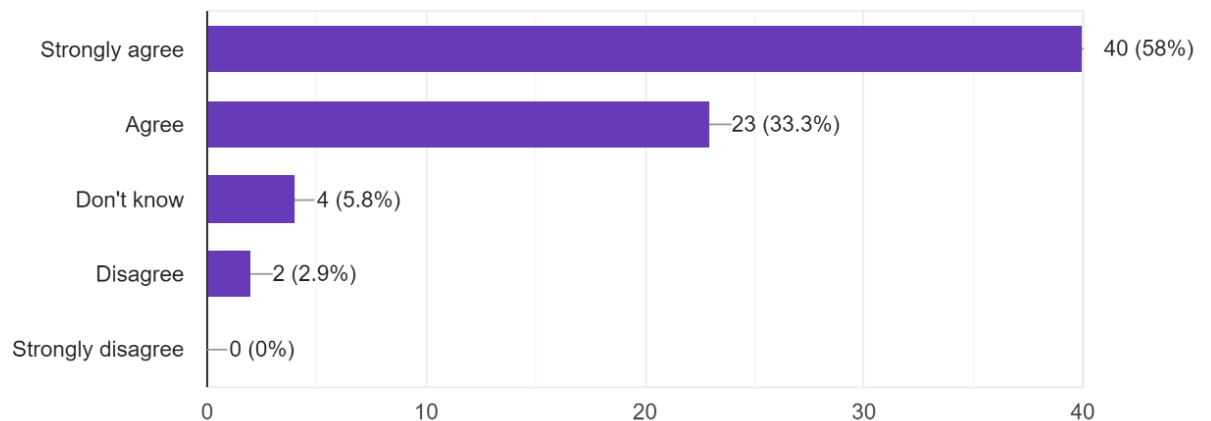
We have pleased that 88% of parents say their child feels safe at our school and only one parent disagreed with this statement. We are striving to ensure that this percentage increases to 100%. We have a wide range of effective systems & procedures to ensure that all children are SAFE. Mrs McKinney is our Designated Safeguarding Lead and we have three Deputy Designated Safeguarding Leads in school. We have effective internet filtering systems, and we teach the children about staying safe online. Our safeguarding governor meets regularly with our Headteacher to make sure we are working effectively. Our Pastoral lead, Mrs Doherty provides support to children and families. We use the 'KIVA programme' to ensure that we tackle any cases of bullying. We also promote positive relationships through the Gospel Virtues and mutual respect. One of our three school rules is 'Be safe', we ensure all children and staff understand what this means at St. Alban's. We promote a culture of safeguarding with staff, children and visitors and are vigilant.

The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved.

Our behaviour policy is based on mutual respect and we are delighted that our pupils feel valued and loved. 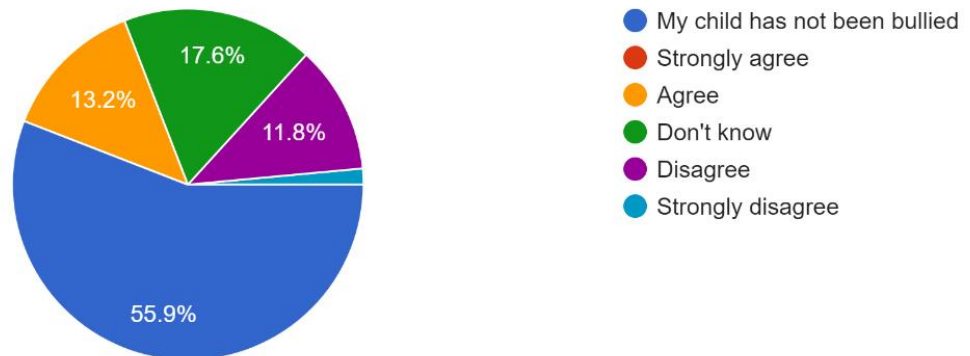

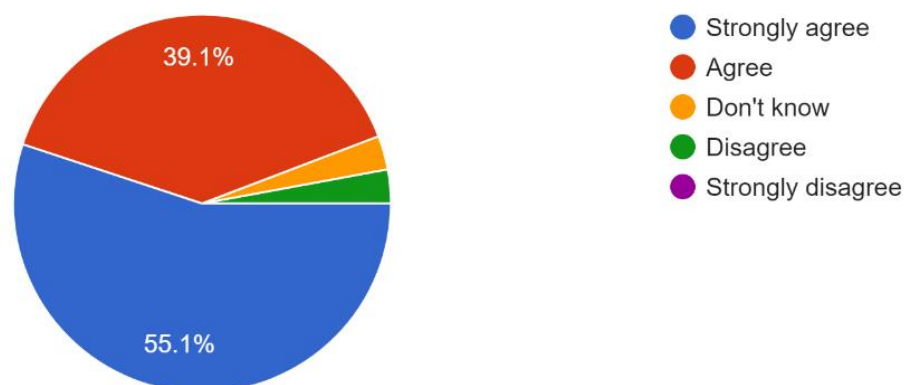
My child has been bullied and the school dealt with the bullying quickly and effectively.

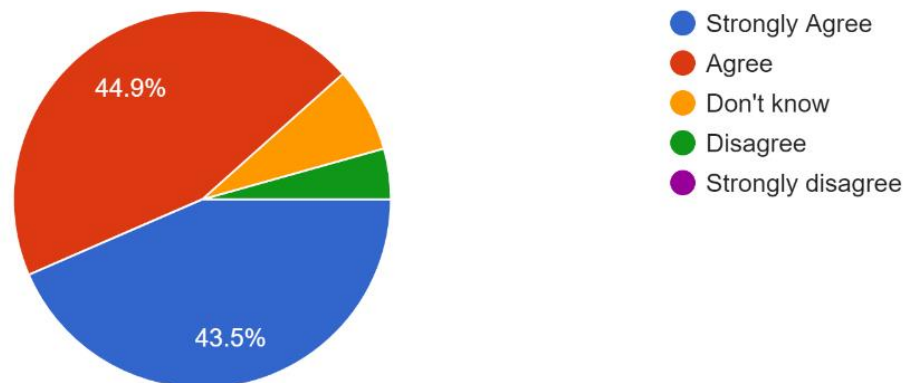

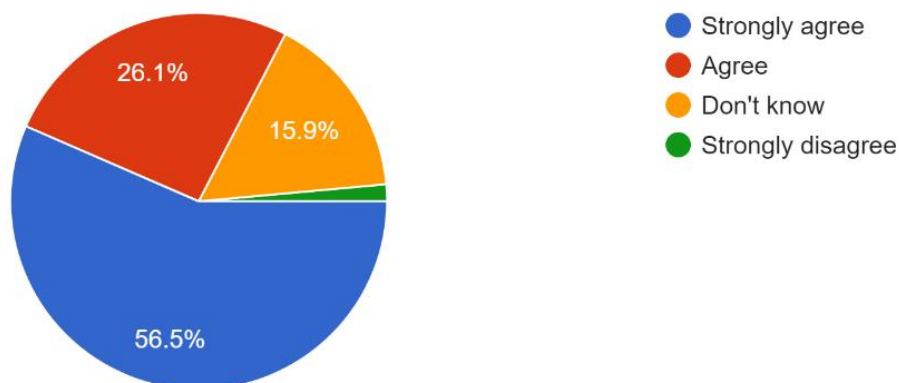

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When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.

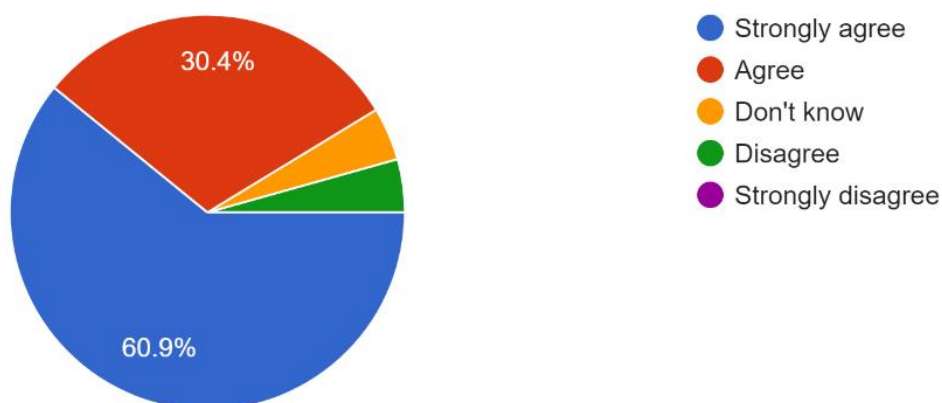
