

How we intend to use our Sport Funding in 2016-2017

In 2016-2017 we plan to use our £8893 of sport funding to:

- To continue to enhance the quality of our PE lessons by enhancing the skills of our Senior Leader in PE and also class teachers through team teaching with specialist sports coaches, access to Sports Premium Primary Programme (Bishop Challoner) and PE hub access to support planning and assessment.
- To ensure pupil premium children are able to access before and after school sports clubs.
- To provide non swimmers in Key Stage 2 with an intensive swimming programme– this is in addition to our normal swimming provision.
- To continue to provide Upper Phase children with a competitive day of athletics at a specialist venue.
- To widen the range of specialist sports offered in school. This will be delivered by specialist sport coaches. This will include:
 - Street dancing
 - Rugby
 - Yoga
- To continue to enhance the opportunities for children to play competitive sports. Funding will be used to provide cover for staff, specialist equipment and help with transport costs. Competitions entered this year include:
 - o Local inter school competitions for netball and football
 - o Tolkein school dance festival
 - o 6-a-side girls and boys football tournaments
 - o Badminton competition
 - o Netball league and cup competitions
 - o Volleyball competition
 - o Swimming gala
 - o Rounders league
 - o Soft-ball cricket tournament
 - o Cross country competition
 - o Athletics competition
- To purchase new fitness equipment for the school playground to improve fitness levels.
